Louisa May Alcott's family saga Little Women may have been written in 1868, but its influence still reverberates around the world today. Indeed, when Greta Gerwig's movie was launched earlier this year, it was striking how many women around the world spoke of reading it as a key memory from their childhood. If that doesn't include you (and believe us, this is a book for all ages and genders), we'd urge you to find out what all the fuss is about. You'll soon fall in love with the March sisters, who experience hard times while their father is away at war, testing the bonds between them. Download The Invisible Man on Audible (opens in new tab) Listen to a sample: There have been lots of TV, comic and movie adaptations inspired by The Invisible Man, including the 2020 thriller that hit cinemas earlier this year. Yet none save the 1933 black and white movie actually follow the original story by HG Wells, so if you haven't read that yet, you're in for a real treat. Published in 1897, this dark and punchy tale follows an optics scientist who turns himself invisible and then, despite his best efforts, can't figure out how to reverse the experiment. Gripping from start to finish, this chilling novel helped establish Wells as "the father of science fiction". 03. Pride & Prejudice Pride and Prejudice is a romantic novel of manners written by Jane Austen in 1813 that still captivates audiences around the world today. Why? In part because, rather than being either pure fluffy romance or misery porn, there's an underlying realism at its beating heart that reflects social relationships authentically. And so while society may have changed over the years, the challenges and trials faced by the main character, Elizabeth Bennet, remain compelling. This is a beautifully written story embracing universal themes; one which continues to entrance readers across the globe. 04. Dracula Enjoyed the latest BBC adaptation of Dracula, now available on Netflix? Then check out the audiobook of the original too (Image credit: BBC/Netflix) A century before Buffy and Twilight captured the hearts of emo kids everywhere, Irish author Bram Stoker's novel first popularised vampires within the world of literature. But in all that time, and despite spawning generations of questionable genre fare, this 1897 novel has never ceased to be a must-read. The story tells the tale of Count Dracula's attempt to move from Transylvania to England to find new blood and spread the undead curse, and of the battle between Dracula and a group led by Professor Abraham Van Helsing. It's told not as a straight narrative, but as a series of letters, diary entries, newspaper articles, and ships' log entries; but once you get used to that, you'll soon be hooked. 05. Jane Eyre Charlotte Brontë's Jane Eyre might be an academic staple now, but on its publication in 1847, it was very controversial, due to its intimate, first person narrative. From the first line to the last ("Reader, I married him"), the book's main character addresses us personally and intensely, and the potency of the effect remains strong even today, especially in audiobook form. Packed with twists and turns, emotion and tragedy, this romantic, but not sentimental story really packs a punch with a modern-day audience. 06. Alice's Adventures in Wonderland Yes, Alice's Adventures in Wonderland is a children's book. But if you're looking for the ultimate escapism during lockdown, then you can't do better than this weird and anarchic tale of a young girl's nightmarish trip down a rabbit hole to a magical land. If you haven't glanced at it since your own childhood, you've probably forgotten how brilliantly and wittily written it is, and how mindbogglingly surreal it gets in places. What's more, some of the social and political metaphors that passed over your head back then will probably gain new meaning now you're all grown-up. 07. The Curious Case of Benjamin Button Written by F. Scott Fitzgerald and first published in 1922, The Curious Case of Benjamin Button tells the story of a man who ages in reverse: born with the appearance of an 80-year-old man, he then spends his life looking younger and younger. If the 2008 movie starring Brad Pitt went on too long for you, then good news: the original is actually a short story. And it's a brilliant one, too, effortlessly pulling you into the character's mysterious world, and making you empathise with his struggle as the ultimate outsider from society. 08. Around the World in 80 Days Written by Jules Verne in 1873, this classic tale sees Phileas Fogg of London and his French valet attempt to circumnavigate the world in 80 days for a big-money bet. It's quite simply a rollicking adventure featuring well-crafted characters and a ton of excitement. While times may have changed, there's a grand vision and an underlying humanity to this story that makes it as enticing and entertaining as when it was first published. 09. Les Misérables The audiobook of Les Misérables is a very different experience to the musical movie featuring Anne Hathaway (Image credit: Working Title Films) Long before it became a hit musical, or was turned into a film, Les Misérables was a much-loved historical novel by Victor Hugo. Published in 1862, it follows the lives and interactions of several characters in the period culminating in the 1832 June Rebellion in Paris. Pulling in multiple themes, from politics and moral philosophy to architecture and urban design, this isn't a light read, nor a particularly happy one, but you will find it a profound experience you won't regret, and will never forget. 10. The Jungle Book Written in 1894 by English author Rudyard Kipling, The Jungle Book is a collection of children's stories set in a forest in India. Telling the tales of a series of animals, including Shere Khan the tiger, Baloo the bear, and Mowgli, a boy raised in the jungle by wolves, it may have inspired the Disney adaptations, but only broadly: it's very much its own set of stories. Charming, entertaining and often thrilling, this is a must-read for audiences of all ages. Topics covered are: acceptance sampling, Shewhart control charts for Phase I studies; graphical and statistical tools for discovering and eliminating the cause of out-of-control conditions; Cusum and EWMA control charts for Phase II process monitoring; design and analysis of experiments for process troubleshooting and discovering ways to improve process output; and multivariate control charts for Phase I and Phase II studies with multiple Quality characteristics. Origins of statistical quality control is presented in Chapter 1, and the technical topics presented in the remainder of the book are those recommended in the ANSI/ASQ/ISO guidelines and standards for industry. The final chapter combines everything together by discussing modern management philosophies that encourage the use of the technical methods presented earlier. This would be a suitable book for a one-semester undergraduate course emphasizing statistical quality control for engineering majors (such as manufacturing engineering, or industrial engineering), or a supplemental text for a graduate engineering course that included quality control topics. A unique feature of this quality control book, is that it can be read free online at by scrolling to the author's name (John Lawson). A physical copy of the book will also be available from CRC Press. Prerequisites for students would be an introductory course in basic statistics with a calculus prerequisite and some experience with personal computers and basic programming. For students wanting a review of basic statistics and probability, the book Introduction to Probability and Statistics Using R by (Kerns 2011) is available free online at (. A review of Chapters 3 (Data Description), 4 (Probability), 5 (Discrete Distributions), 6 (Continuous Distributions), 8 (Sampling Distributions), 9 (Estimation), 10 (Hypothesis Testing), and 11 (Simple Linear Regression) will provide adequate preparation for this book. In this book, emphasis is placed on using computer software for calculations. However, unlike most other quality control textbooks that illustrate the use of hand calculations and commercial software, this book illustrates the use of the open source R software (like books by Cano et. al. (E. L. Cano, Mogguerza, and Redchuck 2012) and Cano et. al. (Cano, Mogguerza, and Corcoba 2015)). Kerns's book (Kerns 2011), mentioned above, also illustrates the use of R for probability and statistical calculations. Data sets from standard quality control textbooks are used as examples throughout this book so that the interested reader can compare the output from R to the hand calculations or output of commercial software shown in the other books. As an open source high-level programming language with flexible graphical output options, R runs on Windows, Mac and Linux operating systems, and has add-on packages that equal or exceed the capabilities of commercial software for statistical methods used in quality control. It can be downloaded free from the Comprehensive R Archive Network (CRAN). The RStudio Integrated Development Environment (IDE) provides a command interface and GUI. A basic tutorial on RStudio is available at gulzar/rstudio/basic-tutorial.html. Additionally Chester Ismay's book Getting used to R, RStudio, and R provides more details for new users of R and RStudio. It can also be read online free by scrolling down to the author's name (Chester Ismay) on and a pdf version is also available. RStudio can be downloaded from . Instructions for installing R and RStudio on Windows, Mac and Linux operating systems can be found at . The latest version (3.0) of the \(\verb!lqcc\ package!\) is illustrated in this book. The input and output of qcc version 2.7 (that is on CRAN) is slightly different. The latest version (3.0) of \(\verb!lqcc!\) can be installed from GitHub at using devtools:install_github("luca-scr/gcc", build_vignettes = TRUE) For students with no experience with R, an article giving a basic introduction to R can be found at . Chapter 2 of Introduction to Probability and Statistics using R by (Kerns 2011) is also an introduction to R, as well as the pdf book R for Beginners by Emmanuel Paradis can be downloaded from . All the R code illustrated in the book plus additional resources can be downloaded from by clicking on the cover of this book, and then on the link for code in a particular chapter.
